



(NOTE: THE FULLOWING LETTER IS THE TEXT OF A SPEECH MADE BY MRS. ALEKA EMMERLING AT CABRILLO COLLEGE, APRIL 3,1970)

"WE ARE ALL CONCERNED TO SOME EXTENT WITH OUR ENVIRON-MENTAL POLLUTION PROBLEM. DAVID EMMERLING IS WHOLEHEARTEDLY CONCERNED ABOUT POLLUTION BECAUSE IT IS OUR CHILDREN THAT WILL LIVE OR DIE ON OUR ANSWERS TO THE PROBLEMS THAT FACE US NOW. HE HAS RUN INTO A PROBLEM THAT I, ALEKA EMMERLING CANNOT ANSWER AND I AM NOW ASKING YOU FOR AN ANSWER.

"THE MIDDLE AGED GROUP IN THIS COUNTRY KEEPS REPEATING OVER AND OVER AGAIN THAT THERE IS A "GENERATION GAP". I MUST AGREE THERE IS A GAP AND I FEEL THIS GAP IS CREATED BY A VERY FEW PEOPLE IN THE MIDDLE AGED GROUP, NOT ALL BUT JUST A FEW PEOPLE IN SUCH A POSITION THAT EFFECTS ALL OF US, YOUNG AND OLD. THEY ARE CREATING A POLLUTION IN OUR ENVIRON-MENT. THIS POLLUTION IS "MIND POLLUTION" WHICH IS TRANSMITTED RIGHT INTO OUR HOMES.

"KSBW CHANNEL 8 IN SALINAS IS BROADCASTING ITS FREQUENCIES AND "MIND POLLUTION" INTO OUR COUNTY THROUGH THEIR NEWS RE-PORT. ROY STEARNS, A NEWSREPORTER FOR KSBW INTERVIEWED DAVID WILLIAM EMMERLING PRIOR TO HIS OFFICIAL DOCUMENTATION INTO THE PUBLIC EYE AS A WRITE-IN CANDIDATE FOR SHERIFF-CORONER OF SANTA CRUZ COUNTY. DAVID WAS NOT ALONE AT THE IN-TERVIEW. PETER CHANG (DISTRICT ATTORNEY), TOM KELLEY (COUN-TY ELECTIONS SUPERVISOR), MRS. WILLIAMS (ATTORNEY), WALLACE WOOD (SENTINEL REPORTER), AND THE VALLEY PRESS REPORTER (NAME NOT KNOWN), WERE THERE WHEN DAVID EMMERLING REFERRED TO HIMSELF AS A "CITIZEN" AND HE ALSO SAID HE WANTED THE \$20,400 SALARY TURNED BACK TO THE COMMUNITY FOR A COMMUNITY PROJECT LIKE A FLOWER GARDEN TO BRING THE SENIOR CITIZENS AND YOUNG PEOPLE BACK TOGETHER SO THAT THE ART OF GROWING FLOWERS WILL NOT BE LOST. THIS, OF COURSE, WOULD HELP CLOSE THE GENERATION GAP. KSBW IS NOT INTERESTED IN HELPING THE CITIZENS OF OUR COUNTY. THEIR NEWS REPORT TO YOU WAS DEVISED TO CREATE HATRED, DISTRUST, CONTEMPT AND RIDICULE BY REFER-RING TO A THOUGHTFUL CITIZEN AS A "HIPPY". THIS WORD IS USEC BY THE MASS MEDIA (KSBW) TO REFER TO, AS YOU KNOW, A PERSON THAT IS UNTRUSTWORTHY, DISLOYAL, LAWBREAKER, DIRTY, ETC. THEYALSO REPORTED AS "FACT" THAT DAVID WANTS TO BUY FLOWERS WITH THE MONEY. MAY I ASK HOW CAN HE BUY FLOWERS WITH THE MONEY IF IT IS GOING BACK TO THE COMMUNITY?

"AS YOU CAN SEE THERE WAS A COMPLETE DISTORTION OF THE NEWS REPORT. DAVID TELEPHONED KSBW AND ASKED FOR A RETRACTION AND A TRUE STATEMENT, KSBW REFUSED. DAVID THEN MAILED A LETTER TO KSBW, NO REPLY FROM KSBW. HE WENT TO A LAWYER AND WAS TOLD THAT THIS IS NOT A COMMUNITY PROBLEM. WHAT DO YOU THINK? ARE THEY UPHOLDING THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES AND THE MEANING OF DEMOCRACY? IS KSBW HELPING OUR COUNTY, OUR COMMUNITY?


